EDWARD MCKINNEY LONG, b. 18 Oct 1832 in Texas, d. 20 Jun 1926 in Elm Mott, McLennan Co., Tx., buried in White Rock Cemetery, m. 25 Feb 1858 Waco, Tx. Elizabeth (Bettie) Masters, b. 28 Jan 1832 Texas, d. 3 May 1909 Elm Mott, McLennan Co., Tx., buried White Rock Cemetery. Children:

1. J. D. (DAVE) LONG, b. 11 Jun 1861, d. 20 Jun 1931, m. Tranquilla Christian, b. N.K., d. 10 Dec 1941. Both buried in White Rock Cemetery.
2. WILLIAM JACKSON (BILLY) LONG, b. 6 Feb 1868, d. Jan 1948, m. Fannie Wickliff, b. 22 Jan 1879, d. 29 Feb 1960. Both are buried in Midland, Tx.
3. MOLLY LONG, b. 1 Mar 1870, d. 30 Jun 1928, m. 3 Jun 1895 John Thomas Lawson, b. 2 Feb 1866, d. 28 Jun 1932. Both are buried in White Rock Cemetery.
4. MAUD LONG, b. 16 Mar 1872, m. 1891. Rance C. Smiley, b. 1 Feb 1872, d. 27 Jul 1957. MAUD died 16 Jan 1950, both are buried in White Rock Cemetery. Rance and John T. Lawson are said to be cousins also.
5. ELIZABETH (LIZZIE) LONG, b. 1875, d. 7 Nov 1952, m. William Traywick, b. 30 May 1872, d. 27 May 1926, both are buried in White Rock Cemetery.
6. GEORGE B. LONG, b. 4 Nov 1877, d. 1 Mar 1902, buried in White Rock Cemetery.
7. SALLIE LONG, b. 1879, d. 1955, m. Arthur Stewart, b. 1875, d. 1947. Both are buried in White Rock Cemetery.

All the children were born in McLennan Co., Tx. as far as I have been able to ascertain. I understand that WILLIAM J. (BILLY) LONG moved his family to Lynn Co., Tx. about 1914 while the rest remained in McLennan Co., John Lawson and MOLLY LONG moved to Lynn Co. for a short while but returned to McLennan Co. Their second oldest child, Kate Lawson, married in Lynn Co. in 1917, to Robert Henry (Bob) Ferguson. Kate and Bob are my grandparents. I have most of the names of the grandchildren of EDWARD and BETTIE LONG if anyone is interested in them.

BENJAMIN LONG 1837 - 1910

Records of the United States Army, Company "A", 58th Regiment, Ohio Volunteer Infantry: BENJAMIN LONG, b. 4 Jul 1834 Noxubee County, Mississippi, enlisted 27 Sep 1864, Cincinnati, Ohio, discharged 25 Jul 1865 Vicksburg, Ms., next day entering local hospital, subsequently hospitals at Canton and Grenada, Ms., granted pension for chronic diarrhoea.

BEN LONG made his way north by 22 Nov 1868 Hocking, Co., Oh. where he married Mary Elizabeth Brian, a sister of an Army buddy, and the dau. of John S. Brian, who died of typhoid fever in Pittsburg Landing, Tenn. 9 May 1862, while serving with this same 58th Ohio Regiment.

The 1880 U.S. Census: BENJAMIN LONG, age 43, cannot write, self and parents all born Louisiana, Mary (Brian), born Ohio, both parents born Maryland; BAZEL 10, ANN 6, both Ohio. In the Special Census of 1890, Ohio Veterans and widows, BENJAMIN LONG of Laurel Twp., Hocking Co., Ohio, states he left the Confederate Army in Vicksburg, and joined the U.S. Army in 1864. The 1900 census has BENJAMIN LONG, b. Jul 1837 Miss. father born Pa., mother b. Alabama.

BENJAMIN LONG died 17 Apr 1910 Hocking Co., Ohio, his death record states he was born Louisiana, his father's name was JOHN. BEN was very secretive about his past, not telling anyone much about his origins. We have rumors of his being captured by the North and being imprisoned in Camp Chase, Columbus, Ohio. The keeper of such records in Columbus told me that he personally knew, from his own researchers that this enlistment was made in Camp Chase, and not in Cincinnati.

1850 U.S. Census of Mississippi, Leake Co., family #285 JOHN LONG, age 46, born North Carolina, wife SIDNEY age 38, born Tenn., BENJAMIN age 13, JOHN 12, JAMES 8, WILIE 6, MARY 5, WILLIAM 1, all born Mississippi. ELIZABETH age 16 at the end of this list.

Early Tyrell Co., N.C. records show both Wiley and LONG intermarriages and living within close quarters, near Taney Branch Creek land called "Suttans Neck" (mid 1700s). LONG given names were BENJAMIN, THOMAS, JOHN, GILES, JOSHUA, JAMES and ANDREW. Wiley given names were John and James. ISAAC LONG married Rhoda Wiley 10 Sep 1767 there.

In the above material, those items following the death record of BEN LONG are not proven to be connected to him, but are possible routes to follow, any and/or all LONG and Wiley information is being sought from the south, for the completion of this family line.

He attained rank of Sergeant. In 1775 EVANS LONG was 13 years old. He was given land for his service, 200 acres on 19 Feb 1784.

RICHARD LONG, b. Virginia, married Sara English, dau of Abraham English RICHARD was in Gloucester Co., Va. 1652 Book 3, page 135, son ABRAHAM died 1703 Gloucester Co., wife MARY who marries 1705 Major Robert Peyton, dau ANN receives her brothers land and sells it to Robert Peyton. She married John Forrest and has a son, Abraham who dies in 1759 Amelia Co., Virginia.

RICHARD LONG is said to be his father, in Isle of Wight 1623-23 Bass's Choice, wife and infants. 1625 RICHARD age 33, b. 1592, ALICE age 23 in 1620 came in "London Merchant", RICHARD a child born Virginia.

Am trying to find proof that this last RICHARD is ours. Can prove RICHARD of Gloucester Co. who married Sara English is ours. Any help or suggestions would be greatly appreciated. My address above.

WILLIAM LONG, b. Ga., ca 1818. Wife unknown. They probably wed in Alabama 1827-29, in Covington, Fayette-Franklin-Jackson-Madison-Limestone Co. according to 1830 census.
