Matilda Jane Laudette, 71, of Llano, died April 15, 1985. Services were held in San Antonio on April 18, with the Rev. Henry Talbot officiating. Mrs. Laudette was born December 26, 1913, at Lima, Bandera County, Texas, the daughter of Charles Thomas Sherman and Lillie Ethel Long. Her husband, Mike Laudette, and two preceded her in death. She was a member of the VFW Post 4815 Auxiliary in San Antonio.

She is survived by four daughters: Mrs. John (Evelyn) Wade of Llano, Mrs. Tom (Elsie) Fordham of Pomona, Ca., Mrs. Donald (Patsy) Thomas of Llano, and Mrs. Clifford (Rena Ann) Patton of Port Lavaca; two sons, Jimmy Elijah Smith of Kalamazoo, Michigan and Emil Thomas Smith of Clarksville, Tennessee; one brother, Clarence T. John Edward Hatcher, b. ca 1727 prob. in Chesterfield Co., Va., d. ca 1781/82 (will probated 28 Jan 1872 in Bedford Co., Va.), md. 1st Hulda Tice, and md. 2nd Sarah ?????.

Of the 13 children of John Edward and Hulda Hatcher, Elijah Hatcher, was b. ca 1756 Bedford Co., Va. Elijah m. 1st ??? and had 7 children, among them John Hatcher, b. 6 Jan 1797 Bedford Co., Va.

John Hatcher m. Charlotte Claytor(n) Thurmon, dau. of David and Susannah (Leftwich) Thurmon, on 7 Jun 1822. Charlotte b. 1806 Franklin Co, Va. John and Charlotte later moved to Pike Co., Il. (1840 census) and of their ten children, a daughter Charlotte Elizabeth Hatcher was b. 11 Jan 1838 in Ky. (Where they lived for awhile before settling in Ill.)

Charlotte E. Hatcher m. WILLIAM FRANKLIN LONG on 14 Aug 1857 in Pike Co., Ill. WILLIAM, who served in the Civil War, was b. 21 Mar 1837 in Pike Co., Ill., the son of ABNER NELSON LONG and MARTHA JANE (Gale) LONG.

WILLIAM F. and CHARLOTTE (Hatcher) LONG had 11 children:

MILITARY SERVICE OF JOHN LONG

JOHN LONG, Pvt. Co. I, 30th Reg't Indiana Infantry, from Jan 1862 to Aug 1862; Sep 1862 to Apr 10, 1863; Mar 1863 to Sep Oct 1863; continues to Nov. 25, 1865 when he was mustered out. Was absent, present, captured, paroled. JOHN LONG first appears on the rolls for Jan-Feb 1862, but the Company Muster and Descriptive Rolls shows this information: JOHN LONG, Pvt, Co. E (New) 30 Reg;t Ind. Inf. Roll dated at Huntsville Alabama Feb 10, 1865. Born Ohio, age 25 yrs, occupation Farmer, when enlisted Jan 8 1864, where enlisted Whiteside, Tenn. for 3 yrs. Eyes, grey, hair Dark, complexion Dark, ht: 5'5", mustered out at Victoria, Texas. Father's address: JACOB LONG, Esq., Leesburg, Kosciusko Co., In. Another record shows he was discharged at Indianapolis, Ind. Nov. 25, 1865.

Marriage License, State of Indiana, County of Kosciusko;

To All Who Shall See These Presents, Greeting. JOHN LONG and Elizabeth Miller were married the 20th day of December 1866, by Chas. H. Sheffield, Justice.

Declaration for Pension: JOHN LONG, Garnett, Kansas Apr 8, 1915.

JOHN LONG, born 7 Oct 1841 Boliver, Ohio., m. Elizabeth Miller, no children, received pension, died 24 Apr 1922 at Garnett, Anderson Co., Ks. Elizabeth died 7 Apr 1943.

LONG-ROWE FAMILY

My great great grandparents, ROBERT W. LONG md. Catherine P. Rowe, dau. of Asa L. and Charity Hughes (Moss) on Aug. 1, 1846 in Talladega Co., Alabama. Recorded in marriage bk. A, page 447. ROBERT and CATHERINE LONG were listed in the 1850 census of that county. Their 1st two children were listed, ADALINE age 2 and WESLEY age 1. Also listed in the household was KENNEDY LONG age 22, b. Tenn. A few households from ROBERT and CATHERINE LONG in Talladega Co., was a JEREMIAH LONG, age 49, b. N. C. Other members listed were JANE, age 24; H. T. age 23; NANCY, age 21; ELIZABETH age 20; SARAH age 19; JANE age 17; BENJAMINE age 12; and WILLIAM age 11. Living in the next household from JEREMIAH LONG was a MARY LONG, age 79, b. N.C. Was MARY LONG mother of JEREMIAH? Was JEREMIAH LONG father of ROBERT W. LONG?

ROBERT W. and CATHERINE LONG moved to Texas and were recorded in the 1860 census of Hallettsville, Lavaca Co., Tx. They remained in that county and assume that they both died and are buried in or near Hallettsville, Tx. CATHERINE LONG was still alive and listed on the 1900 census. Have been unable to acquire a death certificate on her. The children of ROBERT W. and CATHERINE LONG were:

LONG'S IN THE REPUBLIC OF TEXAS

WILLIAM D. LONG, b. 1810 South Carolina, arrived in the Republic in the spring of 1837 from Tennessee, with wife Nancy Albright. They settled in Rusk Co., moved to Kaufman Co. 1860. He died there 1863. What became of son WILEY, b. ca 1842 Tx. and son JAMES, b. 1832 Tenn.?

JAMES MADISON LONG, b. ca 1811 South Carolina, arrived in the Republic spring of 1837 with wife Mary Harrison. Settled in Harrison Co., moved to Hopkins Co. 1850's. Died there 1877, buried in LONG Cemetery Hopkins Co. Son's PETER H., FRANK, SAMUEL died Hopkins Co. What became of children COLUMBUS, JAMES, REBECCA and MARY ANN? There were other girls in this family. Probably married in Harrison Co., Tx. This family from Tennessee.

TOBIAS LONG arrived in the Republic 1837 Montgomery Co, b. 1798 North Carolina, came to Texas from Tennessee. Returned to Tenn., sold land in McNairy Co., Tn. 1846. Brought his family to Texas 1846-47. In Upshur Co. 1850, in Wood Co. 1860. Wife was Margaret O'Neal. All children born Tenn., JAMES, oldest son, lived and died in what is now Franklin Co., Tx. What became of children POLLY, ROBERT PERRY, ELIZABETH JANE, JOHN O., REUBEN, EMALINE and DORCUS? MARTIN is known to have once been in Hopkins Co. WILLIAM died in Civil War. Where are TOBIAS and MARGARET buried?

GEORGE W. LONG, b. ca 1815 South Carolina, came to the Republic before April 1837, a single man. Received land grant, md. Sophonra Arnold, they had SARAH and NANCY. Lived in Rusk Co., 1850, in Hopkins Co. 1870. Is he buried in LONG Cemetery in Hopkins Co.?
