In addition to the chart I will list below all of JAMES LONG'S children in case any of those names might have meaning to anyone. These people traipsed all over west Texas in the early days and records are few and far between. According to a county history of Parker Co. the family went to Brown Co. "immediately after the war" moving there from Cherokee Co. where they had lived since 1851. They came to Tx. from Ga. and to Ga. about 1838-39. There is a family history that a Mr. Gatewood went to Llano Co. in about 1900-01 to visit relatives. Unfortunately, we do not know whether he visited LONGS, Gatewoods, or Fairchilds. We know they lived in Parker, Hood, Eastland and Coleman. Possibly others lived in Palo Pinto, Hill, Bosque, San Saba and Llano Co's. JAMES LONG'S children were:

Estates and land records of the LONG family of Somerset Co., Md. featured in pp.87-91, Vol. 7 Issue 4, and pp. 7-13, Vol. 8 Issue 1, of OLL, (extracted from my book, THE BOSTON FAMILY OF MARYLAND), indicates that the following LONGS cannot be descendants of the above LONG family, but their origins are at present unknown.

DAVID LONG, b. ca 1710, d. 1791, m. (St. Martin's Church, now Worcester Co., Md. 26 May 1735) Ann Lockwood, reportedly daughter of Richard Lockwood. Although he was evidently in then Somerset Co. (now Worcester Co.) as early as 1735, DAVID LONG first appears in the tax lists in 1740, in Bogertenorton Hundred (on the seaboard, just below the present Ocean City, Md.). In 1749 he acquired a tract, "Partnership" and later another tract, "Forest Flower", in Dagsboro Hundred, Sussex Co., near Frankford and Dagsboro, Delaware, whither he moved with his family. - ix. ARMWELL LONG, b. 17 Dec 1754 (others have read the date as 12 Feb), d. Sussex Co., 22 Nov 1834, buried Armwell Long Cemetery, Frankford, Del., m. Jul 1773 Elizabeth Robinson.
- x. ANNE (NANCY) LONG, b. 19 May 1756, m. Mr. Scudder (?).
- xi. JOYCE LONG, b. ca 1758, m. Mr. Chamberlen.

JOHN LONG, b. c1705, d. 1753, could very well be an elder brother of the above DAVID LONG, since they lived in the same area. He first appeared in Bogertenorton Hundred in 1733, was listed in the 1735 Somerset Co. Debt Books as owning "Conveniency", 75 acres. On 15 Mar 1735 he purchased the tract, in Mattapony Hundred (just south of Bogertenorton Hundred), from Samuel Ball, with Patrick Guthery joining in the deed (Somerset Co. Deeds 19:54). It was probably this JOHN LONG who petitioned the Somerset Co. Court in Nov 1740 to be levy-free, saying that he had fallen from a horse and had dislocated his right arm so

that he could not support his wife and children by his labor. The petition was granted (Somerset Judicial Records 1740-42, p. 35). JOHN LONG died by 3 May 1743, when bond was posted on his estate, Alexander Bunckle was executor, with Abraham Outten and Peter Claywell as securities. In 1745 the Worcester Co. Debt Books show JOHN LONG'S heirs with "Conveniency", part 75 acres, another part 50 acres. The heirs were still holding it in 1755 and 1756. Children of JOHN LONG:

- i. DELVES NEWTON LONG, b. c1735, d. Worc. Co. 1776, m. (c1758) Mary. As eldest son and heir-at-law of JOHN LONG, on 6 Apr 1759 DELVES LONG sold the 125 acres of "Conveniency" to Parker Selby, for 25 pounds, MARY, wife of DELVES, giving her consent (Worc. Deeds D:379). In a deed of 8 Nov 1769 Joshua Guthery, Capt. Parker Selby and DELVES NEWTON LONG deeded the tract to John Outten Sturgis (Worc. Deeds H:203). DELVES LONG and Guthery apparently signed in a confirmatory capacity, Parker Selby, of near Snow Hill, in his will, signed 20 Feb 1773, mentioned a "plantation where DELVES LONG lives." A bond was posted in Worc. Co. in 1776 for the estate of DELVES LONG, who had died intestate, nearest of kin was Levin Newton. In October Court 1784 an indenture bound ELIAKIM LONG, orphan of DELVES LONG, to McKemmie Porter, to learn the art of cordwainer, ELIAKIM was declared to have been 13 years of age the 13th of Sep last. DELVES LONG'S family is derived from Perrin, HISTORY OF BOURBON, SCOTT, HARRISON AND NICHOLAS COUNTIES, KENTUCKY (1882), according to which ELIAKIM was from near Snow Hill, Md. Children of DELVES LONG:

1. WILLIAM LONG, b. 24 Nov 1766, d. Worc. Co. 1796, m. Nancy Bishop? Bond was posted for his estate in 1796 by NANCY LONG, two inventories of his estate (1796-1797) named next of kin Rachel Bishop and ELIAKIM LONG. According to Perrin, WILLIAM LONG was killed by a horse, he had two daughters, who married and migrated to the West, and a son, who went to sea and was never heard from again.
2. Daughter, m. John McCauley, migrated to Ky., they had two sons, both of whom left children in Ohio.
3. ELIAKIM LONG, b. 13 or 16 Sep 1771, d. Bourbon Co., Ky. 11 Apr 1842, m. (Bourbon Co. 11 Jan 1798) Jemima Victor, b. Snow Hill, Worc. Co., Md. 9 Sep 1779, living with son LITTLETON in 1850 in Nicholas Co., Ky. Children of ELIAKIM and JEMIMA (b. Bourbon Co., Ky. from Bible records):

Although his parentage is not known, JOHN LONG must certainly be a son of JOHN and a younger brother of DELVES LONG, in view of the remarkable similarity between the names of JOHN'S children and those of DELVES' son, ELIAKIM. "KETERON" LONG, in her will, made 9 Feb 1790 (prob. 7 Mar 1790), named all the following children except JESSE (Somerset Co., Md., Wills EB 17:100).
