SEARCH FOR JOHN CLARK LONG'S FAMILY

JOHN CLARK LONG was born somewhere in Tennessee in 1846 and came to Washington Co., Ark. I've been unable to find records to identify his parents. His first wife, Nancy Ann Wood? is buried in Reece Cemetary east of Fayetteville, Ark. Her grave is a coffin-shaped, stone burial vault above ground with four tiny vaults to the south. They have solid slabs on top with carved information on them. They are as follows:

"In memory of MARY E. LONG, daughter of J. C. and N. A. LONG, d. Sep the 3, 1871, age 1y 22 d."

"In memory of ANN E. LONG, daughter of J. C. and M. E. LONG, d. Jan 10th, 1877, age 2y 3m 24d."

"In memory of FLOTILLA R. LONG, daughter of J. C. and M. E. LONG, d. June 22, 1880?, age 4m 24d."

"In memory of infant son of J. C. and M. E. LONG, d. Sep 15, 1881."

"In memory of NANCY A. LONG, wife of J. C. LONG, d. Aprile the 30th 1872, age 23y 5m 27d."

In another part of the cemetery is another group of LONG graves.

"Sacred to the memory of SARAH LONG, dec'd this life March the 24th 1862, aged 40 yrs."

(on her left) "M. B. - SARAH LONG'S dec'd child"

"In memory of HENRY W. LONG, son of M. B. and SARAH LONG, dec'd May the 4th 1869?, aged 1y 3m 10d."

WILLIAM GARRETT LONG, b. 17 Aug 1863, d. 5 Jun 1923, m. Cora Cassady of Lisbon, Lake Co., F., b. 20 Jul 1869, d. 24 Oct 1916. WILLIAM G. LONG was a Tax Collector of Lake Co., Fl. for 33 years, and was succeeded in office by his oldest daughter, PEARL. Issue: PEARL, m. Joseph Cullen, both now deceased; no children; ESSIE m. William Leonard Duncan, son of Henry H. and Marian Peet Duncan, both now deceased, children: William Leonard Duncan of Ormond Beach, Fl. and Joe Douglas Duncan of Tavares; identity of the wives and children of both men not known to me at the present; THELMA m. Marvin Miller of Havanna, Fl. where both still live.

Am sending the 1850 census of Warren Co., Ga. as alphabetized by Mrs. W. W. Otto. I have underlined and made marginal notes beside the names of members of the family of ALFORD (or ALFRED) LONG, son of LITTLETON LONG and MARTHA (Shelton) LONG, both formerly of Halifax Co., N.C. and later of Hancock Co., Ga. Briefly, ALFORD'S widow, Hannah m. Anthony Jones and moved to Warren Co. The children, whose names are taken from Hancock County Court records appointing as their guardian were: William JEFFERSON LONG, ALFRED M. LONG, MARY ANN FRANCES LONG and EMILY MIRIAM.

ALFORD LONG had brothers CRAWFORD LONG, and DAVIS LONG, whose family data you already have. Sisters, in addition to my great grand mother NANCY LONG, were: ELIZABETH LONG, m. John Patterson; SARAH LONG m. 1st Obadiah J. Shivers, m. 2nd Abner M. Kelley; and another who m. John Bird. I do not have family data on these last three.

In previous correspondence I have mentioned a HENRY LONG, SR. of Hancock Co., Ga. He was a Rev. Soldier of Halifax Co., N.C., m. Ann Pope. HENRY LONG'S will was written in 1824; and it was proved later during the same year, with his son HENRY LONG, JR., appointed as executor on 1 Nov 1824. HENRY LONG JR. was a resident of Forsyth, Monroe Co., Ga.

The survivors of HENRY LONG, SR. were: ANN LONG, widow; HENRY LONG, JR., JOHN LONG of Hancock Co., and Patsy Randle, whose husband, Peter Randle signed for her share of the estate. The enclosed copy of page 24 of Hancock Co., Ga. 1850 census lists the family of JOHN LONG'S widow, MILLEY (White) LONG. I have no data on the family of HENRY LONG, JR. Data on the family of PATSY LONG is listed next.
