- (1) Hugh Finlay Fonds – 1773-1793 – Report on the Lake Temiscouata Road (1786) and Quebec Route 1787; I have copy of the textual record but I am looking for the Map?

a. Quote from custodial history “topographical drawings and manuscripts in Kings Maps CXIX; most of these items many of which are listed in the Finding Aid No. 599, are hold in the Cartographic and Architectural Archives Division (CAAD) of the Documentary Art and Photography Division. At some time prior to 1955, however, Hugh FINLAYs 1787 postal route report (Kings Mapx CXIX, 59-2-a) appears to have been transferred to the Manuscript division by CAAD. The associated map (Kings Maps CXIX, 59-2-b) remained in CAAD (their reference NMC-117639); in 1990 a photocopy of it was placed with the report in the Manuscript division for the convenience of users.”

Understand how the process works look for right people and how to extract – lots of records and ANQ – educated guess – series names – surveyor general notebooks “poll books”

27 metres – website for ANQ

At Confedderation Uited province

Records already consolidated between 1840-1867

Lots of material not in active use – some stayed in vaults in Mtl or Quebec – nicely biographical – list of volume titles – substantial – General Post Office – Imperial – tends to be annual report to senior management – plan for that portion of the Portage – Surveyor General in Quebec City (ANQ) – 1830's – special surveys – 1829-1833

Surveyor – Samuel Holland – 1764-1785 – Surveyor General 1791 – Deputy Joh Collins for British North America (Bouchette – junior in Holland office – surveyor general of woods – white pine for the Crown – any office survey reports on the Temiscouata – whether to enlarge location improvement

Expoloration Carig's Road – 1810 and 1814 – Returns of survey of certain lots – Lotwer Canada – Land Petitions – page volume 27 pages 14532-14631

They want reliable person – loyal could read and write – literacy and numeracy

Craig Petition – took it home – survived

Prevost – dies before inquiry – second world war – bombed

Private papers of British Colonial Governors – Manuscript commission 1807-1812 bits and pieces – most of the incoming – wer useless – letter book of replies Volume 1200-1400

Know to approximate date – then there might have been a reply – look into Cruikshank – table of content for letterbook – beginning or end of volume – 1800 Finding Aids first reel

Grand Voyer – ANQ – Surveyor keeps his own set of accounts

1812 – Poastage Accounts – each department may be submitting postal expenses

1815 – Grand Voyer – passed legislation – internal communications – improvements and settlements – Commissioners – region by region – organized by districts – the need regional representatives –

1818 – placing meridian sontes – org by commissioner (alpha numeric by district)
